# WHAT IS Sustainable Labs Canada?

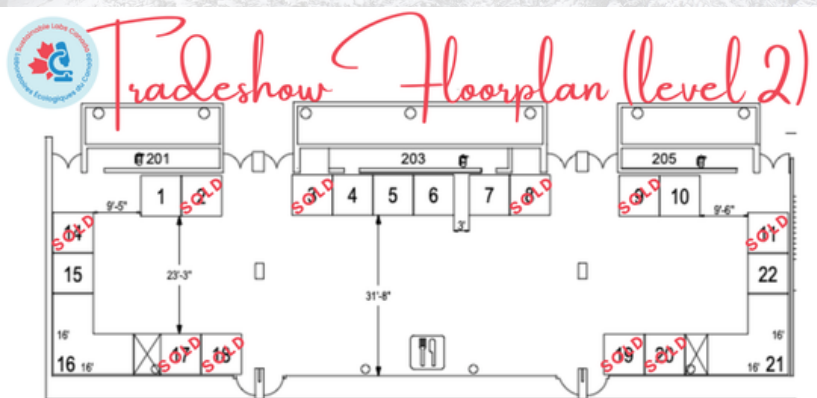
